


Christ

• Jesus Christ is the Creator (Eph 3:9; Col 1:15-18). God with Him created the Heavens & the earth & made man. "Let Us make man in Our image" (Gen 1:26; 2:7). HE IS:

• The Lord (YHWH-Eternal) God (El-Almighty) of the OT—the Lord to Israel and to the Church (Deut 6:4; Mk 12:28-37; Ac 2:32-36). God (OT-Elohim, NT-Theos) is a collective noun like family (Eph 3:14-15)

• The "Word" (LOGOS-Spokesman-John 1:1,3,14), the "I Am" & "Rock" & "Deliverer" of Israel before His human birth (Ex 3:13-15; 12:41-42; Mal 3:1-6; Heb 13:8; Ac 7:31-38; 1 Cor 10:4), & "Melchizedek" (King of Righteousness, King of Peace-Heb 7:1-2; Gen 14:17-20)

• He gave up His power & glory, humbled Himself to

the earth" (cenesis 1:1)

• He is Immanuel (God with us-Isa 14:7; Mat 1:23), the Bridegroom (Mat 9:15; 25:1-13; John 3:29; Isa 62:5), & the Alpha & Omega-Rev 1:8,11; 21:6-7; 22:13-Aleph-Tav in OT-not translated - Gen 1:1, 27; Isa 29:23; 52:10; 53:6,8)

• Jesus name (Gk-Iesous from the OT Yahshua-Joshua- YHWH-yasha means Jehovah Savior (Mat 1:1.21: Lk 1:31: John 19:19: Acts 4:10-12; Phil 2:5-10: Isa 45:15,21-22; 49:26)

• Christ-"Messiah" or "Anointed One." Kings and priests were anointed (Ex 29:7; 1 Sam 16:1-13). Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit, the power of God (Lk 3:22; Acts 10:38)

#### What was His Mission?

- Jesus came to demonstrate God's love for us (John 3:16-17; Rom 3:21-26; 5:8; 1 Pet 2:24)
- He became human to experience human trials, suffering & death, learn obedience & have compassion for our trials in brotherly love (Heb 2:14-18; 5:1-2,5-9)
- Jesus healed all manner of diseases as proof He was the Messiah, (Mat 4:23-24) & performed many miracles by the power of God—i.e. water to wine, fed 5000, walked on water, etc. (Jn 2:2-11,23; 3:2; 10:37-38; Mat 14:15-31; 15:29-39; Lk 5:1-11)
- He fulfilled OT prophecies, as proof of the Bible (Mat 5:17-18; Lk 18:31)
- He came to do the Father's will (John 5:30,36; 6:38-40; 12:49-50) & reveal the Father as Head of the God Family (Mat 11:27; Jn 5:19-30; 1 Cor 8:6; 15:23-28; Eph 3:14-15; Rev 21:1-7)
- He came to obey & teach spirit of God's law—love of God & man—setting example & turn us from sin (Mat 5-7; 12:1-14; Mk 2:27; Ac 3:13-26; 2 Cor 3:6; 1 Pet 2:21; 1 John 4:7-21)
- He preached the gospel (good news) of the soon coming Kingdom of God and the way of salvation (Mat 6:33; 19:16-26; Mk 1:14-15; Lk 4:4,16-22; John 3:5,14-21; Eph 1:13)
- He came to prepare disciples to build His church & become His bride (firstfruits of salvation) & witnesses of the gospel to the world (Isa 49:8,18; 61:10; 62:1-5; Mat 10:1-42; 16:18: 18:1-35: 24:14.22; 28:18-20; Mk 6:7-13; 9:33-42; 10:13-16,35-45; 16:15-18; Lk 10:1-24; 22:24-30: John 6:37.44-45.70: Acts 1:8: 2 Cor 3:2-6; Rev 22:17)
- Jesus was tested as we are & overcame the world and Satan to qualify and replace him as ruler over this world (Lk 4:1-13; Jn 16:33; 2 Cor 4:4; Heb 2:18; 4:15; 1 Jn 2:14-17; 5:4)
- He qualified to become our High Priest & Savior to make intercession for us and reconcile & justify us with God (Heb 4:14-16; 5:1-10; 7:22-27; Rom 5:1,6-11,18-21)
- He established the New Covenant with His disciples (Lk 22:20; Heb 5:6-13; 10:9-23)
- His final act as the Son of Man was to redeem & deliver us from sin that cuts us off from God (Isa 59:1-2) by submitting Himself to be unjustly tried, convicted & crucified by man (whose sins He came to redeem), giving His life as a sacrifice & ransom (Mat 20:28; Lk 23:1-25; Acts 2:36; 1 Tim 2:5-6). He who did no sin thus fulfilled the curse (penalty) of breaking the law for us (Deut 11:26-28; Isa 53:2-12; Mat 5:17; Rom 6:23; Gal 3:13: 1 Pet 2:21-25). Greater love has no man than this! (John 15:12-13)

What did Jesus fulfill on earth

- Jesus taught the gospel (good news) of the Kingdom of God (God's government) coming soon to bring lasting peace, prosperity, happiness and true success for all (Mat 4:17,23; 5:2-12; Mk 1:14-15; Lk 23:1-4; John 18:33-37; Isa 2:1-4; Isa 11 & 35) replacing evil tyrannical governments of this world that make war, conquer and oppress, causing poverty, misery, slavery and death for most (Dan 2:44; 7:15-27; Rev 13,17,18)
- He taught His disciples **how to pray** (Mat 6:5-15; Mk 11:22-26; Lk 11:1-13; 18:1-14)
- He taught the **law of God's Kingdom—love** is the spirit & fulfillment of the law (Mat 4:4; 5:17-20; 7:12; 22:36-40; Mat 5-7; John 13:34-35; 14:21; Rom 13:8-10; 1 Cor 13)
- He taught the **gospel of salvation**, **forgiveness** of sins, and how to receive **God's gift** of **eternal life** (Mk 10:17-22; 16:16; 18:21-35; Lk 6:37; Acts 2:21,38-39; Eph 1:13)
- He taught how we can become sons of God & enter His kingdom (Jn 1:12; 10:7-11,27-29) and the rewards of the saints (Mat 16:27; 19:27-29; Lk 19:11-27; Rev 2:7; 3:21; 19:7-9; 20:6)
- He taught many things in **parables** only for His disciples to understand (Mat 11:25; 13:10-18,34-35), i.e. the sower & seed, wheat & tares, pearl of great price (vs. 18-52); house built on sand/rock (Mat 7:24-29); lost sheep, coin, son (Lk 15:4-32); rich man, wicked husbandmen, wedding invitation, 10 virgins, talents (Mat 19:16-29; 21:33-46; 22:1-14; 25:1-30); rich man & Lazarus, Pharisee & publican (Lk 16:19-31; 18:9-14), etc.
- He taught His disciples to carry on God's work (Mat 28:19-20; John 14:12-31; 21:15-17)
- He foretold His own death & why He had to die (Mat 16:21; 20:17-19)
- Jesus warned of false christs, prophets, ministers & disciples coming in His name teaching doctrines of men & demons (Mat 7:15-23; 24:4-5,11,23-26; 1 Tim 4:1; Rev 6:1-2)
- He prophesied of the things that would come to pass before He returned (Mat 24; Rev 1:1)

#### Why did God allow Jesus to be crucified?

Jesus lived a perfect sinless life, why did God allow Him to die? The answer is to redeem man from the curse (penalty) for sin & reconcile us to God (Rom 5:10-11; 6:6-23; Gal 3:13; Heb 9:11-28).


But why couldn't God just forgive our sins without a sacrifice? The reason is God's perfect law of love (Mat 22:36-40; Rom 13:8-10) is immutable. The penalty (curse) for sin (breaking that law is the law of sin - Rom 7:23-25; 1 John 3:4) is eternal death with no hope of an afterlife, "*The soul that sins shall die*" (Eze 18:4, 20; Rom 6:7,23; Eph 2:12; 1 Thes 4:13; Rev 20:14; 21:7-8).

God will not compromise His law (Mat 5:18). The only way possible for God to forgive our sins was for God Himself to fulfill the law and pay the penalty for us (Mat 5:17-20; Rom 5:6; John 3:16). God planned from the foundation of the world that Jesus Christ would give His life for man if he should sin (1 Pet 1:3-21; Rev 13:8). He demonstrated His love by giving His life for each of us that we could become sons of God (Rom 3:24-26; 5:8; 1 John 3:1-3).

#### "It is finished" (Jn 19:30)

"Christ our passover was sacrificed for us" (1 Cor 5:7) Jesus fulfilled the Passover sacrifice and Atonement to redeem man from the curse of sin, finishing (accomplishing and making an end) of the purpose for sacrifices (John 19:30: Gal 3:19.23-25).

"He is risen" (Mat 28.6; Acts 2:24) exactly 3 days and nights later and He appeared to His disciples for 40 days before returning to heaven (Mat 12:40; 28:6; Acts 1:3,9-11; 2:31-36; 10:39-43)

Why did Jesus say, "Many are called, but few chosen" (Mat. 20:16; 22:14)? Who are God's elect (chosen), the bride? (Mat 13:18-23; 24:22; 25:1-10; Mic 6:8)

- Those who believe (Mat 16:13-17; Jn 6:68-69; 7:39; 20:31; Heb 11:6; Jam 1:2-8; 2:14-20)
- Those who abide in (obey) His word (Mat 4:4; Jn 8:31; Acts 5:32; 1 Jn 5:1-3)
- Those who Love God & one another (Mat 22:36-40; 25:34-40; Jn 13:35; 1 Jn 4:7-21)
- Those who hate evil & love & keep His law (Ps 97:10; 111:10; 119:165; Prov 8:13; Jer 31:33; Dan 12:10; Am 5:14-15; John 14:21; 15:10; 1 John 2:3-6; 3:10; 4:7-21; 5:1-3; Rev 1:3)
- Those of humble, contrite, loving, serving spirit (Isa 66:2; Mat 18:3-6; 1 Pet 5:1-7)
- Those who accept God's correction and overcome and endure to end (Heb 12:3-11; Mk 13:13; Eph 5:25-27; Rev 2:7,17,26; 3:5,12,21; Deut 10:12-21)
- As many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the sons of God They purify themselves (Rom 8:9,14; John 1:11-12; 1 John 3:1-3; Rev 17:14; 19:7-9).
- Why are many not chosen as the bride of Christ? (Mat 7:21-23; 25:1-12)
- Don't believe or love God (Jn 5:24,38-47; 6:30-45,64-69; Dan 12:10; Mal 3)
- Love riches, pleasures, cares of world (Mat 13:18-23; 22:1-14; 19:16-24; 1 Tim 6:9-10)
- Don't love the truth (Jn 8:44; 17:17; Rom 1:18,25; 2 Thes 2:10-11; Rev 22:15)
- Love pride, vanity, fruit of man's knowledge & trust in self & man (Gen 3:5-6; Prov 6:16-19; 1 Cor 10:12; 2 Cor 1:9; Gal 5:19-21; 1 Tim 6:3-5; 2 Tim 3:1-7; 4:3-4; 1 Jn 2:15-17)
- Disobedient (Rom 2:1-13; Gal 3:1; 5:7; 6:7; Eph 2:2; 5:5; Col 3:5-10; 1 Pet 4:17; Rev 18:4)
- Some give heed to seducing spirits (2 Cor 11:3-4,13-15; 1 Tim 3-4; 1 Jn 4:1)
- "Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His (Rom 8:7-9)

#### What is Jesus (Yahshua) doing now?

- Jesus is directing the work of His church (Acts 6:1-7; 8:1,4; 9:15; 11:1-30; 13:1-5; Eph 1:22; 4:7-16; Col 1:18-29)
- He is **making intercession** teaching, correcting, encouraging, helping, healing, administering gifts of God's Spirit (Acts 1:8; 2; 3:6-21; 12:5-17; 19:11; Rom 8:26-39; 1 Cor 12:13-18; Heb 7:25; 12:5-11; Heb 13:5; 1 Pet 2:24)
- He is **preparing** the **government of God** to rule the earth, preparing positions and training, testing and selecting saints to fill those responsibilities (Dan 2:44; Mat 19:27-30; Lk 12:42-44; John 14:2,16,26; 16:5-15)
- He is calling & preparing His bride for the wedding (Mat 22:2-14; 25:1-13; Eph 5:22-32; Rev 1:11,20; 19:7)
- He is **fulfilling prophecies** & preparing **for His return** (Mat 24:14,22,29-31; Rev 2,3,11:1-15; 12:6-17)

Jesus' disciples asked, "What will be the sign of your coming and the end of the age?" "Will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" He answered, "It is **not for you to know** times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority" (Mat 24:3; Acts 1:6-7). But He revealed a progression of conditions and events that would occur thru 7 church eras climaxing at the time of the end & His return (Mat 24:32-36; Rev 1:1,11,19; 11:15).

- False prophets→antichrist & Babylonian Mystery religion (Mat 24:4-5,10-11,23-26; 2 Cor 11:3,13-15; 2 Thes 2:3-10; 2 Pet 2:1-3; 1 Jn 2:18-22; Rev 2:2,20; 6:2; 13:11-18; 17:1-7; 18:2-9,24)
- Wars-Armageddon (Mat 24:6-8; Rev 6:3-4,8; 9:1-19;16:12-16; 17:14; 18:17-21-24; 19:11-21)
- Famines, pestilence & earthquakes (Mat 24:7; Rev 6:5-8,12; 8:5; 11:13; 16:18; 18:8)
- Gospel & warnings preached to all nations by 7 churches 7 trumpets & 7 thunders
- →2 witnesses (Mat 24:14; 28:18-20; Isa 58:1; Rev 1:1-3,11,19; 2:1...3:22; 8:1...11:15)
- Betrayal, tribulation & martyrdom→great tribulation (Dan 12:1; Mat 24:9-10,21-22,29; Lk 21:12-16; John 16:33; Rev 2:9-10,22; 3:10,18; 6:9-11; 7:14; 12:13-17; 13:15; 20:4-6)
- Abomination in Holy Place in place of truth (Mat 24:15; Dan 8:11-14; 11:31; 12:11; 1 Cor 3:16-17; 2 Cor 6:16-18; Col 1:13-24; 1 Thes 2:3-4,9-12; Rev 11:1-2)
  - Scoffers-as in days of Noah (Mat 24:37-44; 2 Pet 2:4-6; 3:3-13; Gen 6:5-8,11-13)
  - 7 Beast Govt's rule by political, economic, military & religious power → New World Order for 42 months (Rev 13:1-5-18; 17:7-18; 18:4). True church protected (Rev 12:11-17)
- Heavenly signs→Day (Time) of God's Judgment (Joel 2; Mat 11:20-24; 12:36,41-42; 24:29-31; Lk 21:11,25-28; 2 Pet 2:9; Rev 6:12-17; 8 & 9; 14:6-20; 15:1,5-8; 16:1-21; 18:1-8,20)
- 7th Trumpet—return of Jesus Christ as KING of Kings and LORD of Lords & 1st Resurrection (Mat 24:42; Lk 21:36; Rev 11:15-19; 17:14; 19:6-16; 20:4-6; Joel 2:15-16)
